

SERMON NOTES - Continuing Success

1. Recap of previous ideas

1. God does want us to succeed (see verses below)
2. Success in His eyes is more than worldly ideas of success

The **Worldly** idea of success is:

- Achievement
- Accumulation
- Competition
- Recognition
- **Sensation / feeling**

His "**Good Success**" includes this PLUS...

- It's for Him and others - not ourselves
- It's with eternity in mind - not primarily the here and now
- Salvation and being right with Him is more important than earthly health and wealth

Matthew 16:26 - "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?"

3. This success can be constant and continuing - but only as described below...

2. Troas - Continual success & the fragrance of Christ -

2 Corinthians 2:11-17 NKJV — lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices. 12 Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened to me by the Lord, 13 I had no rest in my spirit, because I did not find Titus my brother; but taking my leave of them, I departed for Macedonia. 14 Now thanks be to God who **always** leads us in **triumph** in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. 15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. 16 To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things? 17 For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ.

Troas and the Fragrance of Christ

- The situation in Troas - confusion and disruption. Paul's 4 different visits to Troas (see below)
- "Fragrance" explained and described
 - Who this fragrance affects - satan, the lost, those being saved.
 - What is the sacrifice that produces fragrance in the Bible? Prayer, worship, sacrifice, service
 - Exodus 30:1, 6-8 NKJV - "1 "You shall make an altar to burn incense on; you shall make it of acacia wood. ... 6 "And you shall put it before the veil that is before the ark of the Testimony, before the mercy seat that is over the Testimony, where I will meet with you. 7 "Aaron shall burn on it sweet incense every morning; when he tends the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. 8 "And when Aaron lights the lamps at twilight, he shall burn incense on it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations."
 - Ephesians 5:2 NKJV - 2 And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.
 - Genesis 8:20-21 NKJV - 20 Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. 21 And the LORD smelled a soothing aroma. Then the LORD said in His heart, "I will never again curse the ground for man's sake, although the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; nor will I again destroy every living thing as I have done.
 - Numbers 16:47-48 NKJV - "47 Then Aaron took it as Moses commanded, and ran into the midst of the assembly; and already the plague had begun among the people. So he put in the incense and made atonement for the people. 48 And he stood between the dead and the living; so the plague was stopped."

- Revelation 5:8 NKJV - 8 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.
- Lk 7:36 - sinful woman with fragrant oil at the pharisee's house. Jn 12:3 - Mary anoints Jesus' feet and the house is filled with the fragrance. Mat 26:6/Mk 14:3 - in the home of Simon the leper.
- Romans 12:1, 2 NKJV - 1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
 - It is the fragrance OF CHRIST
 - It is aimed TOWARDS God - not towards people or satan.
 - It is in OBEDIENCE & it is in FAITH (not looking at outward signs of success)
 - It produces results that last - continual triumph and success. What is God's success? People being saved and disciplined in Church families. The Troas Church is an example.

3. Other points & verses

- HE WORKS ALL THINGS TOGETHER FOR GOOD - Rom 8:28 - "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."
- WHAT IS HIS PURPOSE? - Eph 1:9,10 - "to bring all things back together under one head - Christ" through the Church - Eph 1:22-23
Ephesians 3:10-11 - "to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, 11 according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord,"
- SOME OF THE STRUGGLES PAUL HAD - 2 Corinthians 1:8-10, 2 Cor 4:7-18 - outwardly wasting away yet gaining an ETERNAL WEIGHT OF GLORY.

4. Conclusion.

Serve Him and build His kingdom and body. Plant and build churches. That is what will last. That is success. Build with Gold, silver and precious stones (1 Cor 3:11-16).

Paul and Troas - a Timeline

51AD - PAUL'S FIRST VISIT

Acts 16:6-10 NKJV - "6 Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia. 7 After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them. 8 So passing by Mysia, they came down to **Troas**. 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night. A man of Macedonia stood and pleaded with him, saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." 10 Now after he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go to Macedonia, concluding that the Lord had called us to preach the gospel to them."

Early 56AD - PAUL'S SECOND VISIT "ON THE WAY TO MACEDONIA" (See 2 Cor 2 below* for description of Paul looking for Titus there)

Acts 20:1-13 NKJV - "1 After the uproar had ceased, Paul called the disciples to himself, embraced them, and departed to go to Macedonia. 2 Now when he had gone over that region and encouraged them with many words, he came to Greece 3 and stayed three months. And when the Jews plotted against him as he was about to sail to Syria, he decided to return through Macedonia.

* 2 Corinthians 2:12-14 NKJV - "12 Furthermore, when I came to **Troas** to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened to me by the Lord, 13 I had no rest in my spirit, because I did

not find Titus my brother; but taking my leave of them, I departed for Macedonia. 14 Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place."

Later in 56AD - PAUL'S THIRD VISIT - Eutychus etc.

Acts 20:4 And Sopater of Berea accompanied him to Asia--also Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia. 5 These men, going ahead, waited for us at **Troas**. 6 But we sailed away from Philippi after the Days of Unleavened Bread, and in five days joined them at **Troas**, where we stayed seven days. 7 Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul, ready to depart the next day, spoke to them and continued his message until midnight. 8 There were many lamps in the upper room where they were gathered together. 9 And in a window sat a certain young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep. He was overcome by sleep; and as Paul continued speaking, he fell down from the third story and was taken up dead. 10 But Paul went down, fell on him, and embracing him said, "Do not trouble yourselves, for his life is in him." 11 Now when he had come up, had broken bread and eaten, and talked a long while, even till daybreak, he departed. 12 And they brought the young man in alive, and they were not a little comforted. 13 Then we went ahead to the ship and sailed to Assos, there intending to take Paul on board; for so he had given orders, intending himself to go on foot."

62AD - PAUL'S FOURTH VISIT - NEAR END OF HIS LIFE

Left scrolls there when visiting Carpus.

2 Timothy 4:12-13 NKJV - "12 And Tychicus I have sent to Ephesus. 13 Bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at **Troas** when you come--and the books, especially the parchments."

2 Timothy 4:7-8 NKJV — I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

Small group discussion guidelines

Remember that the aim of the small group is to foster discussion and community, rather than for the leader or one individual to preach to everyone.

1 - Often an **Icebreaker question** is a great way to start discussion. You could ask a question like:

- What were the highs or lows of your week?
- What is your earliest memory?
- If you had to describe yourself as one animal, what would it be and why?
- What is your favourite type of holiday destination?

2 - Next, **read the passage**. You can ask various people in the group to help by each reading a portion of the passage.

3 - These are the **main questions** to ask to understand the passage:

- What is the main message of this talk / passage?
Allow discussion and even diverging from the main topic if it is helpful.
- What did you find particularly helpful or challenging?
- What did you not fully understand?
- What can we do PRACTICALLY in response to this teaching?

4 - Close by offering **prayer** for each person.

- Ask, "how can we pray for you / each other now?"
- Ask each person to pray or you, as leader, pray for each person's need

The blessing and opportunity in Small Groups is the possibility for...

- Each person to contribute and/or ask questions,
- People to pray for each other and to ask for prayer,
- People to learn to use and grow in their gifts,
- Community, friendship and intimacy in relationships.

9. Deuteronomy 2:7 - "7 "For the LORD your God has blessed you in all the work of your hand. He knows your trudging through this great wilderness. These forty years the LORD your God has been with you; you have lacked nothing." ""

For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success."
 16. 1 Kings 2:3 - "3 "And keep the charge of the LORD your God: to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments, His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is

- written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn;"
17. 1 Chronicles 22:13 - "13 "Then you will prosper, if you take care to fulfill the statutes and judgments with which the LORD charged Moses concerning Israel. Be strong and of good courage; do not fear nor be dismayed."
 18. 1 Chronicles 29:12 - "12 Both riches and honor come from You, And You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; In Your hand it is to make great And to give strength to all."
 19. 2 Chronicles 20:20 - "20 So they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.""

"For the pillars of the earth are the LORD's, And He has set the world upon them."
